Research period between one and six months

Publication oriented research

CEU Professorial Fellows \$1500, CEU Visiting Fellows - \$900 per month

Applications for academic year 2011/12 to be submitted by February 15th, 2011

Fellows should:

deliver a public lecture at CEU

submit mid-term and final reports

publish results of research in peer-reviewed journals
