**Postdoctoral Fellowship "Economic History"**

Research Fellowship Heidelberg University, Transcultural Economic History

For the duration of one or two years the Cluster of Excellence "Asia and Europe" is offering a fellowship in Transcultural Economic History to start as soon as October 1, 2010 or anytime thereafter. Successful applicants are expected to have completed their PhD in a discipline like history, economics, or regional studies prior to the start of the fellowship and be fluent in English, one Asian or two European languages. The fellowship will be part of larger international collaborative research projects organized by Harald Fuess, the Professor of Cultural Economic History. The amount of the stipend is based on the postdoctoral fellowship regulations of the German Research Foundation and there will be a small allowance for research and travel. Upon completion of the fellowship a salary upgrade to a full-time lecturer position (TVL-13 with five year duration) will be possible depending upon further funding. Applications with a cover page, a CV and a fellowship project outline of not more than 3 pages and your desired fellowship duration and starting dates as well as a recommendation letter by an academic supervisor should be submitted to Ms Charlotte Kroll by September 25, 2010
