The Association invites you to submit sessions that are as comparative and interdisciplinary as possible. Furthermore, we give priority to sessions, which are co-organised by scholars from different countries/universities. Up to now 10 conferences have been organised: The first one in Amsterdam in 1992, twenty years after we will meet in Prague, Czech Republic, dates: August 29 – September 1, 2012, venue: Charles University in Prague, Faculty of Arts. All are sincerely welcome. The Association supports participation of young scholars by stipends, which cover registration fees, and since 2010 it also offers mobility stipends in a limited number of justified cases.
